30	two thirds of all of the members elected to each House have determined it necessary to enact this measure.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the 10 summary the following:

#### **'FISCAL NOTE**

#### **APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS**

General Fund \$60,232 \$84,184

This bill includes additional General Fund appropriations of \$60,232 in fiscal year 2001-02 and \$84,184 in fiscal year 2002-03 for the Department of the Attorney General to support the Personal Services costs of establishing an additional District Attorney position. The All Other costs associated with District Attorney positions are not supported by the Department of the Attorney General, but rather are the responsibility of the counties.

30 The requirement that a new District Attorney position be established may represent a state mandate pursuant to the Constitution of Maine. The additional local costs related to the 32 All Other expenses of an additional prosecutorial district can Fund 34 not be determined at this time. Unless General appropriations are provided to fund at least 90% of the additional costs or a Mandate Preamble is amended to the bill and 36 2/3 of the members of each House vote to exempt this mandate from the funding requirement, the counties may not be required to 38 implement these changes.'

44 This amendment adds a mandate preamble, inserts an appropriation section and adds a fiscal note to the original bill to establish a new prosecutorial district in Washington County.
