Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §20052, as enacted by PL 1995, c. 499, §1 and affected by §5, is repealed.

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Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §20053, as amended by PL 1997, c. 245, §19, is repealed.

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SUMMARY

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This bill repeals the Long-term Narcotic Dependency Treatment Project since the Federal Government has ruled parts of it unconstitutional. It also repeals a related section that was contingent on the commencement of the project.
