Sec. 1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

This bill appropriates \$80,000 in fiscal year 2001-02 and fiscal year 2002-03 to the Maine Technical College System to maintain "Careers for ME," a multimedia Internet-based career information site to help Maine people learn about careers in Maine, how to prepare for those careers and where the jobs are.
