Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the 8 summary the following:

## **'FISCAL NOTE**

12 Allowing individuals who have previously held certain lobster and crab fishing licenses to obtain the same licenses 14 will increase General Fund revenue and Other Special Revenue collected by the Department of Marine Resources from license 16 fees. The amounts will depend on the number of qualified individuals who choose to obtain a license; the amounts can not 18 be determined at this time.

20 This same change will also increase Other Special Revenue collected by the Lobster Promotion Council from surcharges on 22 lobster and crab fishing licenses. The amounts can not be determined at this time.'

## SUMMARY

28 This amendment is the minority report of the committee. The amendment provides that a person who previously held a lobster 30 and crab fishing license for at least 2 years is currently eligible for the same license. It also adds a fiscal note to the 32 bill.
