FISCAL NOTE

The amendment reduces the General Fund cost of the resolve by \$1,155 in fiscal year 2001-02. The resolve, as amended, includes a General Fund appropriation of \$7,470 in fiscal year 2001-02 for the Legislature for the costs associated with the Commission on Fatherhood Issues.

SUMMARY

This amendment strikes the emergency preamble and the emergency clause and changes the dates by which appointments must be made to the Commission on Fatherhood Issues, the first meeting convened and the commission's report submitted.
