 - **'FISCAL NOTE**

SUMMARY

20 The additional costs associated with certain reporting requirements can be absorbed by the Department of Administrative 22 Services' Bureau of General Services, the Department of Education and the State Board of Education utilizing existing budgeted 24 resources.'

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This amendment removes from the bill the \$15,000 cap on fees 30 charged by the Department of Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of General Services for services associated with 32 a school construction project. It also requires the State Board of Education, the Bureau of General Services and the Department 34 of Education to report back to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over education matters by 36 December 31, 2002 on the results of a survey to assess the level of satisfaction for school construction services provided by the 38 bureau.

40 The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.

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
