COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 151, L.D. 495, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Small Power Production and Cogeneration Laws"

Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 3 in the first line (page 1, line 17 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "Require" the following: ' , whenever the interests of competition, consumers of electricity and economic development in this State are not adversely affected, '

**SUMMARY**

This amendment ensures that the Public Utilities Commission is not directed to promote the State's renewable power producers and cogenerators at the expense of the interests of competition, consumers of electricity or economic development in this State.
