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20 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 388, L.D. 509, Bill, "An
Act to Regulate Waste Transfer Facilities"

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Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting clause and
before the concept draft summary the following:

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'Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §1310-AA, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1995, c.
465, Pt. A, §22 and affected by Pt. C, §2, is amended to read:

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1. **Application for public benefit determination.** Prior to
submitting an application under section 1310-N for a license for
a new or expanded solid waste disposal facility or for a license
for a municipal solid waste transfer station that did not receive
final department approval by March 1, 2001, a person must apply
to the commissioner for a determination of whether the proposed
facility provides a substantial public benefit.

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Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated
from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
