COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 396, L.D. 517, Bill, "An
Act to Establish the Identification Card of a Maine Indian Tribe
as an Acceptable Form of Identification"

24 Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 7 by inserting at
the end a new sentence to read: 'The identification card must
state, at a minimum, the name, date of birth and place of
residence, or mailing address if different from the residence, of
the cardholder.'
