Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §5726, sub-§§11 and 12, as amended by PL 1989, c. 6 and c. 9, §2 and c. 104, Pt. C, §§8 and 10, are 4 further amended to read: 6 Relocation assistance. Provide funds for relocation 11. assistance services and payments to individuals, families and 8 businesses displaced as a result of the acquisition of real property for a public purpose; and 10 12 12. District Court. Construct, equip and furnish a district courthouse within the municipality. The municipality may negotiate a lease with the Chief Judge of the District Court 14 for the use of such a courthouse + ; and 16 Sec. 2. 30-A MRSA §5726, sub-§13 is enacted to read: 1813. Elderly housing. Provide municipally owned rental 20 housing for the elderly. 22 **SUMMARY** 24 This bill enables a municipality to appropriate funds and to 26 issue general obligation bonds to provide municipally owned rental housing for the elderly.
