22 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 398, L.D. 519, Bill, "An  
24 Act to Amend the Licensing Provisions for Private Investigators"

26 Amend the bill in section 3 by striking out all of paragraph  
28 A (page 1, lines 37 to 40 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the  
30 following:

32 'A. Has been employed for consideration for a minimum of  
34 one---year 1,700 hours as an investigative assistant  
36 possessing a valid license issued by the commissioner, as  
38 long as the 1,700 hours of employment occurred within a  
period of no less than one year and no more than 2 years  
from the date of being granted a license;'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment requires 1,700 hours of employment as an  
investigative assistant and requires the 1,700 hours take at  
least one year and no more than 2 years to complete.
