SUMMARY

This amendment changes the title of the bill and reduces the 42 General Fund appropriation for the operation of the Bath Higher Education Center from \$396,000 to \$300,000. The amendment also provides that, prior to the appropriation to the Board of 44 Trustees of the Maine Technical College System for program and operating expenses of the proposed Bath Higher Education Center 46 on the site of the former Mid Coast Hospital campus in Bath, the 48 City of Bath must secure the necessary funds to develop, renovate

and equip the proposed Bath Higher Education Center from private sector and public sector entities. The amendment further permits

the City of Bath to use any unexpended and unobligated funds to support the program and operational budget of the Bath Higher Education Center. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
