Following receipt and review of the report, the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over education matters may report out a bill to the First Regular Session of the 121st Legislature. If the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine System requires a limited extension of time to complete its report, it may apply to the Legislative Council, which may grant the extension.'

SUMMARY

This amendment changes the title of the bill and strikes and replaces the bill with a resolve. The resolve directs the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine System to establish a review of doctorate-level educational opportunities provided through the University of Maine System and to provide a report to the Legislature by December 1, 2002. The resolve also authorizes the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over education matters to report out a bill to the First Regular Session of the 121st Legislature to implement the findings of the program review. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
