COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 419, L.D. 540, "Resolve, to Coordinate and Improve Access To Health Care for Women"

Amend the resolve by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 2. Allocation. Resolved: That the following funds are allocated from the Federal Expenditures Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
