38	§862. Kennebec County Budget Committee
50	In Kennebec County there is established the Kennebec County
40	Advisery Budget Committee to carry out the purposes of this article. The advisery budget committee consists of 9 elected
42	officials and a subcommittee of 6 nonvoting members of the county
44	legislative delegation or their designees as provided in this section.

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Membership; elected officials. The 9 advisory budget
 committee members who are elected officials are appointed as provided in this section.

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In-1991-and-annually-thereafter Annually, the county Α. commissioners shall call a meeting of elected officials within each county commissioner district no later than A public notice of the meeting must be September 15th. issued at least 10 days before the meeting is held. Each commissioner shall serve as the nonvoting moderator of the meeting in that commissioner's district. At the meeting, the elected officials shall nominate a slate of proposed members for the advisery budget committee. Each commissioner shall select one advisory budget committee member from the slate of proposed members within 7 days of the meeting,--except--for--the--soloction--of--the--initial advisory-budget-committee-as-provided-in-subsection-1-B.

1-A. Membership; legislative delegation. A subcommittee of
 6 members of the Kennebec County legislative delegation or their designees shall serve as nonvoting members of the advisory budget
 committee.

A. The subcommittee is appointed by the chair and must be ratified by a vote of the legislative delegation.

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B. The subcommittee shall serve as a resource to the
 advisery budget committee and as a liaison to the
 legislative delegation.

1-B.- Initial election.- Notwithstanding-subsections-l-and 32 3.-in-the-initial-election-of-the-advisory-budget-committee-in 1991,--3--members--are-elected-from-each-county-commissioner 34 district.-One-member-from-each-district-is-appointed-for-a-term of-3-years,-one-member-from-each-district-is-appointed-for-a-term 36 of-2-years-and-one-member-from-each-district-is-appointed-for-a term-of-one-year.

Duties. The advisory budget committee shall review the
 budget estimates prepared by the county commissioners, hold
 public hearings in the county and submit their recommendations to
 the county commissioners.

3. Term of office. The term of office for an-advisery a budget committee member who is an elected official is 3 years,
provided that an-advisery a budget committee member remains an elected official in the elected official's municipality. This subsection--does--not--apply-to--the--initial--advisory--budget committee-members-whose-terms-are-described-in-subsection-1-B.

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Vacancies. The county commissioners shall appoint an 4. 2 elected official to fill any vacancy occurring on the advisory budget committee. A vacancy must be filled from the commissioner district in which the vacancy occurred and is for the balance of 4 the unexpired term. 6 Expenses. Members are not entitled to compensation, but 5. 8 must be reimbursed at the county rate from the county treasury for expenses authorized by the county commissioners that are 10 lawfully incurred in the performance of their duties.

§863. Budget committee organization

The advisory budget committee shall organize and conduct its 18 meetings as follows.

20 1. Organization. The county commissioners shall direct the county clerk to call an organizational meeting of the advisory budget committee no later than 60 days before the end of the 22 county's fiscal year. At the organizational meeting, the 24 committee shall:

- Elect a chair and a recording secretary from among its 26 Α. members; and
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Adopt rules, procedures and bylaws. Β.

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2. Meetings. The advisory budget committee shall determine 32 the time and location of the advisory budget committee meetings. The meetings must be held at times convenient for the public. 34 The advisory budget committee shall keep minutes and record votes for every meeting. The county clerk shall issue a public notice 36 of a meeting no later than 7 days before the meeting is held.

38 The county commissioners shall provide the 3. Resources. advisery budget committee with necessary clerical assistance, 40 office expenses and suitable meeting space, as well as access to county files and information.

Sec. 4. 30-A MRSA §864, as amended by PL 1991, c. 533, §§5 to 44 8 and affected by §10, is further amended to read:

§864. Budget procedures 46

48 1. Commissioners' budget. The county commissioners shall submit an itemized budget estimate, as described in sections 701, 50 702 and 7503, to the advisory budget committee in a timely

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fashion, no later than 60 days before the end of the county's
fiscal year.

2. Budget review process. The advisory budget committee shall develop a proposed budget following review of the proposed itemized budget estimate prepared by the county commissioners, together with any supplementary material prepared by the head of each county department or provided by any independent board or institution or another governmental agency. The advisory budget committee may advise propose that the proposed budget estimate be increased, decreased, altered or revised, provided that:

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A. The advisery budget committee enters into its minutes an explanation for any recommended change in the estimated expenditures and revenues as initially presented by the county commissioners; and

B. The total estimated revenues, together with the amount of county tax to be levied, equals the total estimated
 expenditures.

22 Public hearing. 3. The advisery budget committee shall hold at least 2 public hearings in the county on the proposed 24 budget before the end of the county's fiscal year and before submitting the budget to the commissioners finally-approve-the 26 budget. At least one public hearing must be held in the northern part of the county and at least one public hearing must be held 28 in the southern part of the county. Notice of the hearing must be given at least 10 days before the hearing in a newspaper of 30 general circulation within the county.

 32 3-A. Written notification. Written notice and a copy of the proposed budget must be sent at least 10 days before the public hearing to the clerk of each municipality in the county. The municipal clerk shall notify the elected officials of the proposed budget.

Approval of budget. After the public hearings are 38 4. completed, the advisory budget committee shall adopt a final budget and shall submit its-recommendations that budget to the 40 county commissioners for approval review not later than the end 42 of the county's fiscal year, subject to the conditions and restrictions imposed in subsection 2. The county commissioners may not revise the budget adopted by the budget committee except 44 by unanimous vote of the county commissioners. If the adopted 46 budget is changed by the county commissioners, the budget committee may reject that change by a 2/3 vote of its membership. Those actions are final and are not subject to 48 further action by either the county commissioners or the budget 50 committee.

The members of the Kennebec County Advisory Budget Committee who are elected officials continue to 18 hold office as members of the Kennebec County Budget Committee established in this Act for the remainder of the term to which 20 they were appointed. Following completion of their terms, vacancies are filled as provided in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30-A, section 862.' 22 24 SUMMARY 26 This amendment replaces the bill. The amendment deletes 28 references to "advisory" from the laws governing the Kennebec County Budget Committee. It also eliminates legislative approval 30 for the county budget and empowers the budget committee to submit a final budget to the county commissioners, who may change the 32 budget only by the unanimous vote of the county commissioners. Any changes made by the county commissioners may be overridden by 34 a 2/3 vote of the budget committee. The amendment also makes several technical changes to the laws governing the Kennebec
