46	This amendment clarifies that recreational caving is a
48	recreational or harvesting activity for the purposes of limited liability of landowners under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title
50	14, section 159-A. The amendment also changes the penalty in the bill from a Class E crime to a civil violation and allows a
