Sec. 1. WIC Coupons. Resolved: That the Department of Human 2 Services, Bureau of Health shall adopt rules to authorize both individual farmers and farmers at farmers' markets to accept coupons under the Farmers' Market Nutrition Program, 4 as authorized under the Women, Infants, and Children Special 6 Supplemental Food Program of the United States Child Nutrition Act of 1966, as amended. Rules adopted pursuant to this section are routine technical rules as defined in the Maine Revised 8 Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter II-A. 10

SUMMARY

14 This resolve directs the Department of Human Services, Bureau of Health to adopt rules to allow individual farmers and 16 farmers at farmers' markets to accept Women, Infants and Children Farmers' Market Nutrition Program coupons.
