This amendment requires the Commissioner of Marine Resources to annually examine all dams and other artificial obstructions to fish passage within the coastal waters. The amendment also removes the requirement to adopt rules to establish a schedule of fines for violations involving the improper operation of a fishway. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
