2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7463-A, sub-§8-A** is enacted to read:

6 **8-A. Youth conservation education programs.** Twenty percent  
8 of the revenue generated by the public chance drawing must be  
10 deposited into a special nonlapsing account within the department  
12 to fund youth conservation education programs.

### 14 **SUMMARY**

This bill provides for a percentage of revenue from the public chance drawing for moose hunting permits to be used to fund youth conservation education programs.
