Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

**Sec. 1. Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

#### SUMMARY

This bill provides a General Fund appropriation of \$130,000 in fiscal years 2001-02 and 2002-03 for the Department of Labor, Bureau of Rehabilitation Services, Division for the Blind and Visually Impaired to support the cost of 2 additional Teacher of Blind and Visually Impaired Children positions and related costs.
