COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 474, L.D. 614, Bill, "An Act to Exempt Persons at Least 70 Years of Age from Jury Service at Their Discretion"

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph C in the 2nd line (page 1, line 6 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "may" and inserting in its place the following: 'must'

SUMMARY

This amendment requires a court to excuse a person 70 years of age or older from jury service if that person does not wish to serve on a jury, rather than giving the court an option to excuse such a person.
