	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §662 is enacted to read:
<u>§662</u>	. Conservation easements; development rights not exempt
	Notwithstanding sections 651 and 652, conservation easements
	development rights acquired after October 1, 2001 by any ty are subject to taxation under this Part.
