COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 482, L.D. 622, Bill, "An Act to Eliminate Smoking in Maine Schools and on School Grounds"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Eliminate the Use of Tobacco in Maine Schools and on School Grounds'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "buildings" the following: 'owned or leased or contracted for by an elementary or secondary school'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

The additional workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed in the court system can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department. The collection of additional fines may increase General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT

SUMMARY

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This amendment corrects an error in the title and clarifies that the prohibition on the use of tobacco applies to buildings owned or leased or contracted for by an elementary or secondary school.
