Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

14 The Department of Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of General Services, may require additional General Fund 16 appropriations for site or building plan modifications to ensure that new or reconstructed state office buildings provide bicycle 18 access and shower facilities. The additional amounts that may be required can not be determined at this time.

The Judicial Department may also require additional General 22 Fund appropriations to comply with these new requirements. The amount required can not be determined at this time.'

SUMMARY

28 This amendment strikes the original text of the bill. The amendment requires that the State provide parking for bicycles 30 adjacent to and shower and changing facilities for use by state employees in any new state office building that is built after 32 January 1, 2003 and in any existing state office building that is subject to substantial renovation or any new addition to a state 34 office building that extends beyond the exterior walls of the existing building when the renovation or addition is undertaken 36 after January 1, 2003. The amendment also defines "substantial renovation" and "state office building." The amendment also adds 38 a fiscal note to the bill.
