HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 503, L.D. 643, Bill, "An Act to Allow Municipalities to Lower Certain Speed Limits"

Amend the amendment in paragraph E in the first blocked paragraph in the 4th and 5th lines (page 1, lines 48 and 49 in amendment) by striking out the following: "the qualifying municipality then may" and inserting in its place the following: 'and shall'

Further amend the amendment in paragraph E in the 3rd blocked paragraph in the 5th and 6th lines (page 2, lines 19 and 20 in amendment) by striking out the following: "published by the Federal Highway Administration"

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies at what point a municipality is responsible for setting speed limits. The amendment also strikes the language that speed limits be validated pursuant to the speed limits published by the Federal Highway Administration.
