Sec. 1. Blueberry museum. Resolved: That the University of
2 Maine Cooperative Extension shall develop a plan to create a
blueberry museum in Jonesport and submit a report, including any
4 necessary legislation, to the Second Regular Session of the 120th
Legislature detailing the plan to establish the museum. The plan
6 must include, at a minimum, a projected timeline and work plan
for completing the project, mechanisms for ensuring appropriate
8 funding for the museum and a projected budget for creating and
maintaining the museum.
