2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7406, sub-§2-A** is enacted to read:

6 **2-A. Hunting big game without a guide.** An alien is guilty
8 of hunting big game without a guide if that person hunts big game
10 without being accompanied on the hunt by a person who holds a
12 valid guide license pursuant to section 7311 authorizing that
14 person to act as a hunting guide.

SUMMARY

This bill would make it illegal for an alien to hunt big game without being accompanied by a licensed guide.
