10	C. A trolley trailer, as defined in section 101, subsection 87, when all passengers on the trolley trailer are seated
12	and the towing machine does not exceed 10 miles per hour, or
14	Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §2061, sub-§2, ¶D is enacted to read:
16	D. A person with a disability, as defined in section 521, in a vehicle that requires road service when it is not
18	practical to transport the person with a disability by any other means.
