COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 533, L.D. 688, Bill, "An Act to Eliminate the Requirement that Workers' Compensation Insurers Disclose Certain Cost Breakdowns When Issuing Workers' Compensation Policies"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§2385-B." by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph (page 1, lines 16 to 21 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'When Upon request from an employer, when a policy is issued to employers an employer for workers' compensation insurance, it must be accompanied by a statement disclosing the percentages of premium expended during the previous year by the insurer for claims paid, loss control and other administrative costs, medical provider expenses, insurer and employee attorney's fees and private investigation costs.'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment requires that workers' compensation insurers include detailed cost information with workers' compensation policies upon request from the employer.
