2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 8 MRSA §275-O** is enacted to read:

6 **§275-O. Conduct race; accept wager**

8 Regardless of whether race dates have been assigned pursuant  
10 to section 271, every commercial track must be allowed to conduct  
12 races and accept wagers on those races on any day during which  
14 races conducted at any other racetrack in the State are being  
16 simulcast.

14 **SUMMARY**

16 This bill allows all commercial tracks to conduct live racing whenever any track in the State is simulcasting its races.
