Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the 2 Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 4 Whereas, the State's economy is slowing down; and 6 Whereas, gasoline prices are rising; and 8 Whereas, to provide immediate assistance to all the State's citizens, this legislation needs to be an emergency; and 10 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts 12 create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately 14 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it 16 Sec. 1. Decrease in gasoline tax. Resolved: That, beginning on 18 the first day of the month after the effective date of this 20 resolve and ending on May 25, 2001, the Department of Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of Revenue Services shall decrease the excise tax on all grades of gasoline and 22 diesel fuel by 10¢. 24 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve takes effect when approved. 26 28 SUMMARY 30 This resolve directs the Department of Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of Revenue Services to decrease the 32 excise tax on all grades of gasoline and diesel fuel by 10¢ beginning on the first day of the month after the effective date 34 of this resolve and ending on May 25, 2001.
