2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §5953-D, sub-§4, ¶A,** as enacted by PL 1993,
c. 721, Pt. D, §3 and affected by Pt. H, §1, is amended to read:

6 A. Give priority to those municipalities that are
7 experiencing rapid growth and possess a public service
8 infrastructure inadequate to accommodate that growth, or are
9 service centers, as defined in section 4349-A, subsection 2,
10 with populations under 20,000;

12 **Sec. 2. Allocation.** The following funds are allocated from the
13 Community Development Revolving Loan Fund to carry out the
14 purposes of this Act.
