2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §517-A** is enacted to read:

6 **§517-A. Registration exemption for vehicles owned by**
veterans groups and used exclusively for
ceremonial activities

8 Vehicles owned by organized veterans groups and used
10 exclusively for ceremonial activities such as parades are exempt
12 from registration requirements and registration fees. For
14 purposes of this section, "organized veterans groups" means the
American Legion, Veterans of Foreign Wars and an organized league
of veterans of the United States Marine Corps.

16 **SUMMARY**

18 **This bill provides that vehicles owned by organized veterans**
20 **groups and used exclusively for ceremonial activities are exempt**
from registration requirements and fees.
