FISCAL NOTE

2001-02

APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS

General Fund \$3,080

The Legislature will require an additional General Fund appropriation of \$3,080 in fiscal year 2001-02 for the per diem and expenses of legislative members and other eligible members of the Panel for Repeal of Unnecessary or Archaic Laws and to print the required report.

The additional costs associated with providing staffing assistance to the panel during the interim between legislative sessions can be absorbed by the Legislature utilizing existing budgeted resources. If an extension of the reporting deadline is granted and the panel requires staffing assistance during the legislative session, the Legislature may require an additional General Fund appropriation to contract for staff services.'

SUMMARY

This amendment is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary. This amendment adds an appropriation section and a fiscal note to the resolve.
