2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated  
4 from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

8 **INLAND FISHERIES AND WILDLIFE,  
10 DEPARTMENT OF**

12 **Licensing Services - Inland  
12 Fisheries and Wildlife**

14 All Other **\$250,000**

16 Appropriates funds to be disbursed as grants  
16 to agents authorized under the provisions of  
18 the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 12,  
20 section 7072. These grants must be used for  
22 the purchase of computers, establishment of  
24 internet connections or the installation of  
dedicated phones necessary to implement the  
automation of the department's licensing,  
registration and permitting processes.

26 **SUMMARY**

28 This bill appropriates \$250,000 in fiscal year 2001-02 to  
30 the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to be used as  
32 grants to licensing agents for the purchase and installation of  
equipment necessary to implement the department's automated  
licensing system.
