	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

16	Appropriates funds to be disbursed as grants to agents authorized under the provisions of

20	the purchase of computers, establishment of internet connections or the installation of
22	dedicated phones necessary to implement the automation of the department's licensing,

30	This bill appropriates \$250,000 in fiscal year 2001-02 to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to be used as grants to licensing agents for the purchase and installation of
32	equipment necessary to implement the department's automated licensing system.
