2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §4709-A** is enacted to read:

6 **§4709-A. Gun safety education**

8 A school administrative unit shall require gun safety  
10 education as part of the health education curriculum required by  
12 section 4711.

14 **SUMMARY**

This bill requires gun safety education to be included in the curriculum of elementary schools.
