## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §455, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1997, c. 437, 4 §7, is further amended to read:

 2. Plate designs; optional environmental vanity plates. The Secretary of State, in consultation with the Commissioner of
Conservation, the Commissioner of Environmental Protection and the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife in-consultation
with--the--joint--standing-committee-of--the--Legislature--having jurisdiction--over--transportation--matters, shall determine the
multiple plate design designs.

14 The design designs must accommodate the use of numbers and letters as provided in section 453. Upon request and as provided 16 by section 453, the Secretary of State shall issue environmental plates that are also vanity plates. Environmental vanity plates 18 are issued in accordance with this section and section 453. The Secretary of State may modify class codes and create unique identifiers for the purpose of expanding the program. The annual 20 service fee of \$15 for vanity plates is credited to the Highway 22 Fund. Rules adopted pursuant to this subsection are routine technical rules pursuant to Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter II-A. 24
