Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §521, sub-§9-A, as enacted by PL 1997, c. 673, §2, is amended to read:

9-A. Enforcement of handicapped parking restrictions.
 Local or county law enforcement agencies may enforce handicapped
 parking restrictions on private off-street parking areas. The State Police shall enforce handicapped parking restrictions at
 service facilities established on the Maine Turnpike and on the interstate highway system in the State.

- A. Notwithstanding Title 30-A, sections 471 and 472, any14person may issue a citation for a vehicle or motorcycle that
does not bear a disability registration plate or placard and16is parked in a parking space clearly marked as handicapped
parking. The person issuing the citation shall then report18the violation to the appropriate law enforcement agency,
which shall enforce the citation.20
- B. Local law enforcement agencies shall make available
 22 citation forms that may be used by any person issuing a citation under paragraph A.

SUMMARY

28 This bill augments the county and municipal volunteer parking enforcement programs established under the Maine Revised 30 Statutes, Title 30-A, sections 471 and 472 by amending the law concerning motor vehicle disability registration plates to 32 authorize any person to issue a citation for a violation of the handicapped parking laws.
