Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §8307-B is enacted to read:

§8307-B. Four-year program

A center or region shall provide a 4-year vocational education program to an eligible student under section 8305-A. Along with all other requirements of this Title, the 4-year vocational education program must provide instruction in the machine tool, tool and die making, electrical, plumbing and heating, drafting, electronics and carpentry fields. The commissioner shall adopt routine technical rules to implement the provisions of this section pursuant to section 8306-A and Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter II-A.

SUMMARY

This bill requires that vocational centers and regions provide a 4-year vocational education program for high school students and adults.
