COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 602, L.D. 757, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Maine Workers' Compensation Act of 1992 as it Relates to Medical Payment Coverage"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 17 in the last line (page 1, line 14 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$25,000" and inserting in its place the following: '\$5,000'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in paragraph B in the 5th line (page 1, line 23 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$25,000" and inserting in its place the following: '\$5,000'

Further amend the bill in section 3 in paragraph C in subparagraph (4) in the last line (page 1, line 49 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$25,000" and inserting in its place the following: '\$5,000'

SUMMARY

This amendment, the majority report of the committee, sets the minimum medical payment coverage that an agricultural or aquacultural employer must have to be exempt from the requirement to carry workers' compensation insurance at \$5,000 rather than \$25,000 as proposed in the bill. The current minimum medical payment coverage is \$1,000.
