## COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " to H.P. 602, L.D. 757

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The amendment also changes language relating to the agricultural and aquacultural employer exemption to delete language that appears to require that the minimum liability coverage of \$100,000 per employee be provided in a single employer's liability policy. This change in language allows an employer to meet the requirement for minimum liability coverage by use of an umbrella insurance policy that includes employer's liability coverage.
