Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §456-A is enacted to read:

§456-A. Education registration plates

Subject to the requirements of section 468, the Secretary of8State shall issue education registration plates beginningNovember 1, 2001 in accordance with this section. Education10plates are not required for registration of motor vehicles but
are to allow citizens to participate voluntarily to fund programs12within the Department of Education.

 14 1. Education registration plates. The Secretary of State, upon receiving an application and evidence of payment of the excise tax required by Title 36, section 1482, the registration fee required by section 501 and the administrative fee and 18 contribution provided for in subsection 2, shall issue a registration certificate and a set of education registration 20 plates to be used in lieu of regular registration plates. The Secretary of State in consultation with the Maine Education 22 Association shall determine the plate design. These plates must bear identification numbers and letters.

 2. Administrative fee and contribution to the Education
26 Fund. A person may contribute to the Education Fund by applying for the special registration plates and submitting, in addition
28 to the regular motor vehicle registration fee, a sum of \$20 credited as follows:

- A. Fourteen dollars to the Education Fund established in32subsection 4; and
- 34 B. Six dollars to the Specialty License Plate Fund as established in section 469 for administrative and production 36 costs.

 38 3. Renewal fee. In addition to the regular motor vehicle registration fee prescribed by law, the annual renewal contribution for education registration plates is \$15, which must be deposited with the Treasurer of State and credited as follows:
42 A. Fourteen dollars to the Education Fund established in
