Manager for York County.**

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §82, sub-§4, ¶B,** as enacted by PL 1989, c.
104, Pt. A, §2 and Pt. C, §10, is amended to read:

6 B. The county commissioners of York County shall are
8 entitled to receive the salary specified in section 2,
regardless of whether that county has a full-time county
10 administrater manager.

12 **Sec. 2. 30-A MRSA §82, sub-§6** is enacted to read:

14 **6. York County manager required.** Notwithstanding the other
provisions of this section, no later than January 1, 2002, the
16 county commissioners of York County shall hire a full-time county
manager, who works under their direction to oversee the
18 implementation of county policy and the day-to-day administration
of county operations. The appointment, compensation and tenure
20 of the manager are the same as provided for a county
administrator pursuant to subsections 1 and 2. The manager:

22 A. Is responsible for the administration of all departments
24 and offices controlled by the county commissioners;

26 B. In conjunction with the county commissioners, department
heads and budget committee, shall develop a proposed county
28 budget for the coming year, which must be presented to the
commissioners no later than October 1st;

30 C. Shall keep the county commissioners and the county
32 legislative delegation informed as to the financial
condition of the county and collect all data necessary to
34 prepare the budget;

36 D. Shall attend all meetings of the county commissioners,
except when the manager's removal or suspension is being
38 considered; and

40 E. Shall carry out other administrative duties assigned by
the commissioners.
