SENATE AMENDMENT "H" to S.P. 209, L.D. 774

FISCAL NOTE

4 The requirement that certain confiscated handguns be destroyed by the State will result in insignificant reductions of 6 General Fund revenue from the sale of confiscated handguns through public auctions.

The Bureau of State Police will incur some minor additional 10 costs to destroy certain confiscated handguns. These costs can be absorbed within the bureau's existing budgeted resources.

SUMMARY

16 This amendment narrows the scope of the bill by limiting its application to handguns that were confiscated or forfeited 18 because they were used in the commission of a homicide. It also corrects a clerical error.
