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Authorizing a primitive firearms season for deer will increase annual General Fund revenue collected by the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife by \$12,320 beginning in fiscal year 2001-02. In order to meet the constitutional requirement that the total level of General Fund appropriations must at least be equal to the undedicated revenues collected by the department, the bill includes annual General Fund appropriations of \$12,320 beginning in fiscal year 2001-02 to the Savings Fund program within the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife.

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This bill may increase prosecutions for Class E crimes. If a jail sentence is imposed, the additional costs to the counties are estimated to be \$83.36 per day per prisoner. The number of prosecutions that may result in a jail sentence and the resulting costs to the county jail system are expected to be insignificant.

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The additional workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed in the court system can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department. The collection of additional fines may increase General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'
