'FISCAL NOTE

The Bureau of Insurance within the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation may incur some minor additional costs to implement the bill's new definition of "undisputed claim." These costs can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the bureau.'

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SUMMARY

This amendment adds a new title and replaces the bill. It enacts a definition of "undisputed claim" and clarifies that the definition applies only to claims made for covered benefits under health insurance policies. This amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
