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'FISCAL NOTE

4 The Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources will incur some minor additional costs to designate a department 6 employee to oversee the Maine Agricultural and Internship Training Program and to submit certain required reports to the 8 Legislature. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

This amendment requires the Commissioner of Agriculture, 14 Food and Rural Resources to report biennially to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over 16 agricultural matters on activities relating to the Maine Agricultural Internship and Training Program. 18 It requires a first report by December 1, 2001 including an update on the 20 implementation of a program to identify individuals interested in farm apprenticeships or in purchasing a farm and to establish a network of information to facilitate farm transfers. It also 22 adds a fiscal note to the bill.
