2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6431-A**, as repealed and replaced by PL 1999,
c. 187, §1, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

6 **§6431-A. Trap limit**

8 **1. Limit.** The holder of a Class I, Class II or Class III
10 license issued under section 6421 may not submerge more than
1,200 traps.

14 This bill changes the trap limits for holders of lobster
16 licenses to the levels allowed in 1997.
