Sec. 5.12 MRSA §7901, sub-§24 is enacted to read:

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24. Unlawful sale of a new snowmobile or new all-terrain vehicle. A violation of section 7827, subsection 28 or section 7857, subsection 26 is a civil violation for which a forfeiture of not less than \$500 and a penalty of not more than \$5,000 may be adjudged.'

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Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

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## FISCAL NOTE

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The additional workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed in the court system can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department. The collection of additional fines may increase General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'

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## SUMMARY

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This amendment replaces the bill. The amendment provides definitions for both "new snowmobile" and "new all-terrain vehicle." It also makes it illegal for a person who does not have both a franchise agreement with a manufacturer and a dealer's license to sell more than 2 new snowmobiles or all-terrain vehicles per year. The amendment also establishes that an unlawful sale of a snowmobile or ATV may result in a civil forfeiture of not less than \$500 and a penalty of not more than \$5,000.

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
